## Heathcote, VIC - Low input Viticulture

Since their first vintage in 2005, the Kennedys have aimed to express the famed Cambrian soil of the Mount Camel Range in Heathcote with a more European touch, a style increasingly favoured today. Restrained, elegant and savoury Shiraz and Rosé from Mourvédre and Nero sit in the limelight, with a side of Tempranillo.

After farming in the area for 20 years, they snapped up prime real estate on the upper east-facing slope of the Mt Camel Range. This range marks the Heathcote fault line where the volcanic rock the region is known for was exposed in the Cambrian period. This terroir, along with the elevation and prime aspect, is of course important for former geologist now winemaker Gerard Kennedy, showcased in the wines through wild ferments, little to no adds and calculated maturation.

The Henrietta range boasts youthful, fruit-forward, gluggable expressions of exceptional value. Textured and savoury wines bare the family name and the flagship Cambria shows greater complexity and intensity, rich yet graceful.
