

Lost Buoy Wines



McLaren Vale, SA - Low Input Viticulture

One of the closest vineyards to the sea in Australia, the Lost Buoy vines grow within 50 meters of the cliff edge in Port Willunga, high above the rolling waves of the Great Southern Ocean. With an average age of 15 years, the vines' roots are anchored deep into the Sandstone and Limestone of the cliff head, bringing an intricate minerality to pair with the maritime salinity.

Winemaker Matt O'Leary gently nurtures the fruit through the winemaking process and into barrel with minimal intervention, showcasing the uniqueness of the site. The final wines speaking clearly of the ocean the vineyard overlooks, they show elegance, vitality, crisp maritime acidity and an exciting mineral complexity.
